All cars dropping off and picking up must have a camp dashboard sign

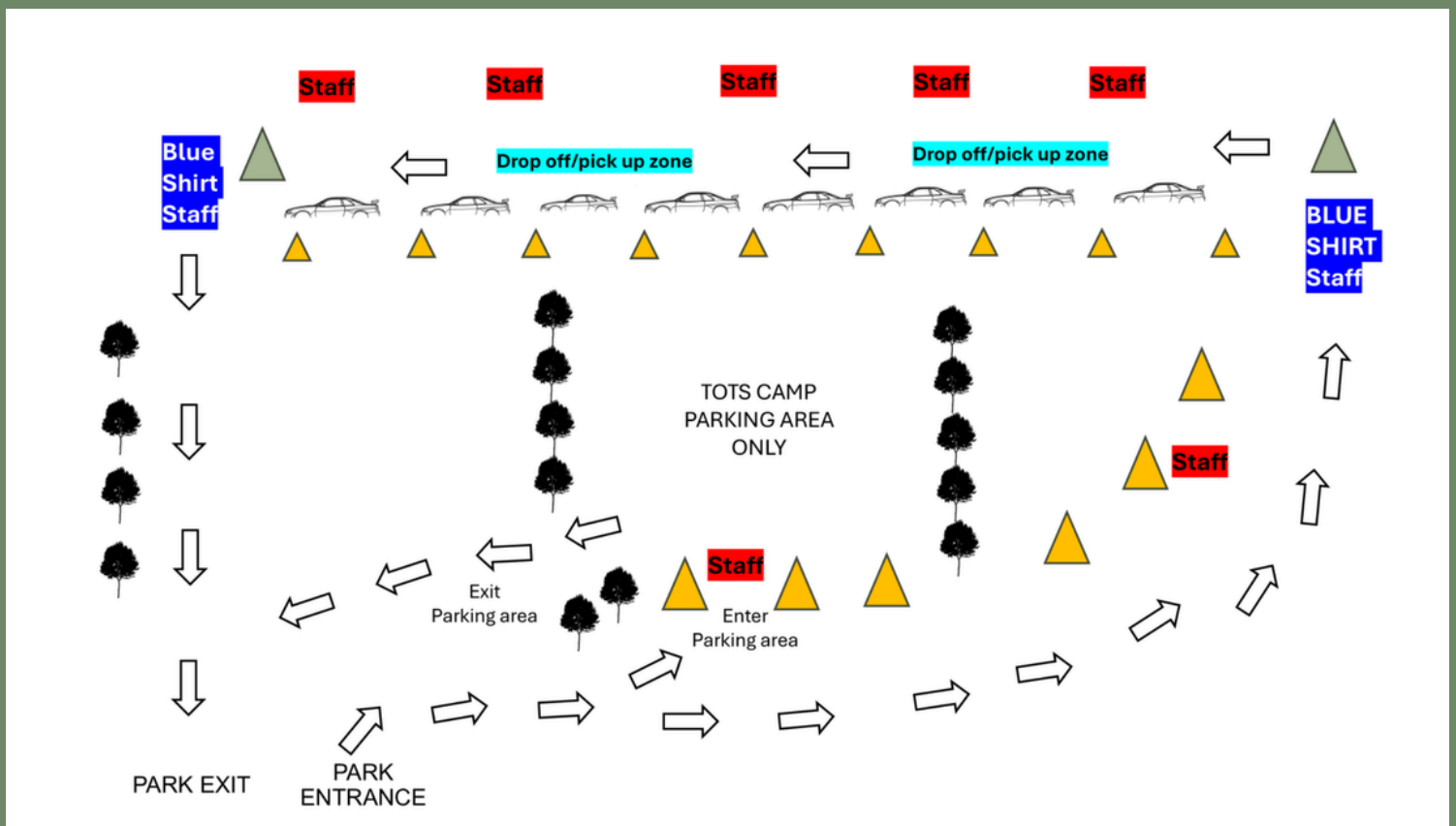
Please NO NOT get out of your car

Instructions

Drop-off

3-6th 8:45-9:00 / K-2 9:00-9:15

- Must stick to your designated time
- Name/Grade sign visible on Dashboard
- Drive around and follow signs
- We will gladly open the car door
- We will escort camper to their group
- Please do not get out of the car

Pick-up

3-6th 2:40-2:50 / K-2 :50-3:00

- Must stick to your designated time
- Name/Grade sign visible on Dashboard
- Drive around and follow signs
- We will walk camper to your car
- Please do not get out of the car

- If you have **kids in different time slots**, then you may select which slot to use
- If **going home with another family** then you **MUST** provide a note at drop-off
- If **arriving late** (after 9:25) then you **MUST** park and walk camper to green shed
- If **going home early** (before 2:30), then you **MUST** park and pick camper up at green shed

***PARENTS ARE ASKED TO PLEASE BE PROMPT IN PICKING UP THEIR CAMPERS. WE WILL WALK EACH CAMPER TO YOUR CAR FOR SIGN OUT.**

SAFETY

The safety of your child is our number one priority. **For the safety of your camper, written parental permission (note) must be sent for the following:**

1. If your camper is to leave camp with a friend, neighbor, relative, or someone other than his or her usual ride. If your child's counselor does not receive a note, your child will not be released.
 2. For car pools or arrangements that will last for the whole summer, one note specifying days and the person picking up/ dropping off your camper will be kept on file for the summer. Please arrange in advance a plan for early dismissal due to inclement weather. We will need to know who we can and cannot release your child to. We will use emergency contacts as approved persons to pick up your child at any time.
- ***Notes should specify your camper's name, group, and counselor as well as the other pertinent information.
