

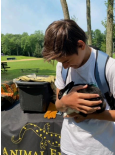

Rain

Always assume we are at the Town Park unless you receive an email from me in the morning calling for a "Camp Rain Day" at Pound Ridge Elementary School.

If we call a "Camp Rain Day" in the morning before camp begins, then we will hold camp for Tots-4th graders at Pound Ridge Elementary School. There will be NO CAMP for 5th-6th graders on those days due to limited space. You will park in the back parking lot and walk your camper to the gym entrance for sign in/out.

If rain occurs during the camp day

- We will do our best to modify the schedule as best as we can.
- If the rain does not let up and thunderstorms are around, we will send an email encouraging you to pick up your camper. Please have back up plans for inclement weather days.
- Safety is our number one priority and if we have to seek shelter during a thunderstorm then these will be the locations.
- K, 1, 2 will be under the lower shelter
- 3, 4 -New upper shelter
- 5, 6 Pool shelter between the locker rooms and the snack bar

Drop-Off & Pick-Up - Please stick to these times

K-2nd grades

Arrival: 8:50-9:00 AM

Dismissal: 2:40-2:50 PM

3rd-6th grades Arrival 9:00-9:15 AM

Dismissal: 2:50-3:00 PM

Instructions:

1. Drive slowly and park car in the parking lot
2. Walk your camper to their group designated by their grade sign
3. Sign your camper in/out on the counselor clipboard
4. After you sign-in/out please clear the area

Sign IN & OUT

Please sign your child IN and OUT each day with your senior head counselor. They will be located at the grade sign where the parking lot meets the field.

You may also provide a list of those that are able to sign your child out. Please fill out our authorization to pick-up form and hand it into the camper's senior head counselor.

Buying Lunch at Camp

You must sign up online in advance. The form will always close at 4PM the Saturday before the week you would like lunch.

Allergies

- We will take every precaution and understand that some children may have allergies.
- However, as far as peanut products go, there is no rule in place about not bringing them because the park is a public area and we would never know if peanut products or allergy related products are left behind for others. (ex. peanut shells)
- So, we discourage peanut products because we might have some allergies at camp but we cannot make it a rule. Please speak with the nurse or the director if you have any questions or concerns.

Birthdays

When a birthday falls in the summer months of camp we will have the birthday child lead our morning line-up and pledge of allegiance. If you would like to celebrate further, you may bring in ice pops to be eaten at the end of the day, for your child's grade on the designated day. Please reach out to the Assistant Director in charge of your group beforehand. (Lena Nurenberg for K, 1, 2 & Jackie Grasso 3,4,5,6) FYI every Wednesday the entire camp gets ice pops at the end of the day.

Medication

All medication must be turned into the camp EMT/Nurse with a doctor's note.
